

SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

Session met on Thursday, August 23, 2017 and below are a few of the highlights of that meeting.

- 1. Heard a short report from representatives of the Pastor Nominating Committee that they are reviewing many Personal Information Forms (PIF) from candidates. They ask for our continuing prayers as they work to discern the person God is calling to our church.
- 2. Reviewed the financial report from July. This is a challenging financial year for us as we are expecting to be taking additional funds from reserves for operating expenses. The good news at this time is that our cash flow has meant we haven't had to do that yet since even though our income is being received at about 50% of budget, our expenses are at 49% of budget!
- 3. Called a Special Session Meeting in the Pastor's Office on Sunday, September 3, immediately following worship, for the purpose of receiving new members. Anyone who is interested in becoming a member of First Presbyterian Church is welcome and encouraged to attend.
- 4. The Health Ministry reported that Flu Shots will be given at the church on Sunday, October 15 from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. These shots are free for Medicare recipients and those giving the shots take most insurance. More details will follow, but for now, mark the date.
- 5. Scheduled a Session Budget Retreat for Friday, October 6, from 9:00 to 3:00.
- 6. Discussed and decided to make no changes in the schedule for worship at this time. That means we will continue with one service on Sunday at 10:00.
- 7. Elected Peggy Imbert as our Commissioner and Patti Snow as our Alternate Commissioner to the Central Florida Presbytery Meeting in Vero Beach on Tuesday, September 12, 2017. Ann Marie D'Alessio will also attend.
- 8. Our church has an opportunity to participate in the Hot Meal Program at First Methodist Church. Session approved for a survey to be conducted to discern the interest of the congregation.


Thank you all for your friendship, support, discipleship, prayers, love, and faith. Words cannot express adequately what you all mean to me and my family.




SEW FOR JESUS
