She had never seen crayons and had no idea what they were, but since they were wrapped in pretty colors, they unwrapped one, thinking it was candy, UGH! At 14 Maiya was born again and asked God how she could serve Him. Taking notes at this time became difficult as I was so involved in her story. But, the family came to America, Cleveland, Ohio. The crayons led her to a life of art, teaching and missionary work. 
