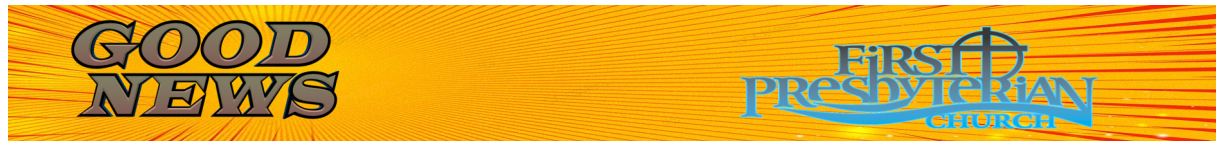

My Dear Friends,

What will you give up? What will you take on?

Lent is upon us, the season the church sets aside to prepare to Easter. It's a great time for introspection and prayer.

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which began on Ash Wednesday, February 22nd, and ends on Holy Saturday, April 8th. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word Lenten, which means "spring." The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to

volunteer and give of themselves for others. Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini -Easter" and the reverent spirit of Lent is tempered with joyful anticipation of the Resurrection.

So, what will you give up? What will you take on in the weeks ahead? I guess the real question is what will you do to connect with God?

Remember how much I love you and look forward to our journey through Lent.
