The host church was coordinated by Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) which arranged the place for our team to stay.

Our two worksite repairs jobs were coordinated and supervised by United Methodist Committee on Recovery (UMCOR). UMCOR provided the team with instructions, materials and tools. Our volunteer team provided the labor.

Every morning the team departed from Buckingham church to our worksites in Port Charlotte to spend our day working on the homes of two single women. Both of our homeowners were so thankful for us helping them as they had no other means to recover their hurricane damaged homes from the storms of 2022.

Working under the supervision of our UMCOR construction coordinators the team worked on task such as replacing a kitchen floor, repairing ceiling drywall and repairing/ replacing soffits and gutters.

Our entire volunteer team of workers put in a full day of hard work which included a half hour lunch break. Please ask any member of our team about what a rewarding experience they had during our 2023 mission trip to the west coast of Florida. It was a great experience for all of us.


