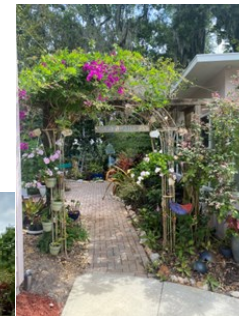

5. Elected Floris Rogers as the Commissioner and Anne Perdue as the Alternate Commissioner to the virtual Central Florida Presbytery Meeting on Thursday, June 6.



**150th TASK FORCE UPDATES FOR JUNE**

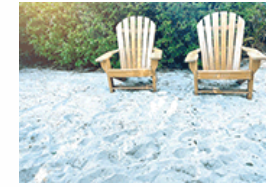

6. Will be recruiting a leader and team members for the Special Events Team.

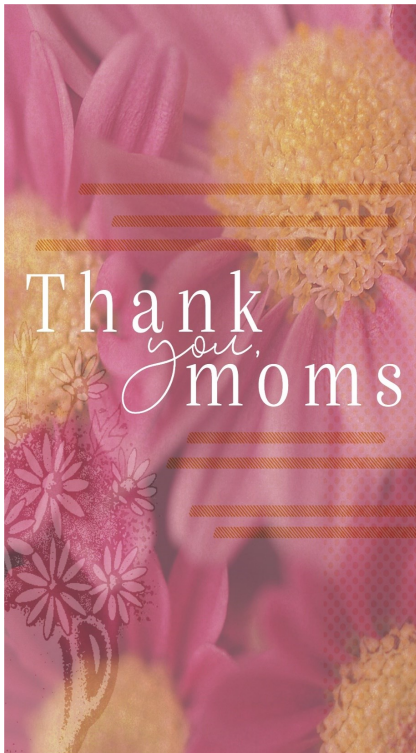




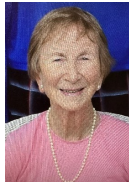
